

7. WFLD –APD in conjunction with APDC Macau and CSLD to run a pre-APDC laser workshop (22 nd May) and Open laser forum in both Mandarin and English at the Asia Pacific Dental Congress.

Following the success of the consecutive collaborations between WFLD-APD and the Asia Pacific Dental Federation, WFLDAPD had supported APDC in laser education at Singapore in 2014, at Malaysia 2015, at Hong Kong 2016.

This year was our 4th collaboration with APDF to support their 39th APDC-Macau. We had run a very success laser workshop in Macau and also gave 2 Open laser forum both in English and Mandarin, in conjunction with the Chinese society for laser dentistry (CSLD). CSLD was formerly in September 2016 and the first collaboration between China and WFLD.



The Synopsis of the Open laser forum Can you tell us something about the Laser open forum? By definition, "Open Forum" implies an open exchange of ideas and information on a topic in a public gathering and to be hosted by a chairperson. The Asia Pacific Dental Congress-Laser open forum is an example of an open exchange of knowledge and experience of the use of lasers in clinical dental produces: using "Questions and Answers", hosted by a chairperson, in both Mandarin and English languages, among a panel of international and local laser-practicing experts and the attendees of the APDC.

What can attendees expect here?

This is a golden opportunity, whereby the attendees can enrich their understanding and knowledge of use of lasers in dentistry on "How laser dentistry can benefit the patient and the dentist" through direct face-to-face or voice-to-voice interactive learning and discussion. This laser modality is indicated in all dental disciplines from diagnosis to treatment; from caries prevention to periodontal management; from pedodontic to orthodontic; from endodontic to implantology; from therapy to surgery; from facial aesthetics to snoring and cancer patients' management etc. This delivers patients with a holistic modality: non-invasiveness, germ-reduction, promote healing and comfort with less use of Local anaesthestic, as well as enhancing treatment outcome and increase patient attendance to allow patient education for early intervention and prevention.
