Dr. Nagai serves as a Board member of the Japanese Society for Laser Dentistry, Asia and Pacific Division of the World Federation for Laser Dentistry and Vice President of the Japanese Academy of Color for Dentistry. He served as the board member of Academy of Laser Dentistry from 2010-2018.He is a committee member of the Japan Academy of Esthetic Dentistry, Japan Society for Laser Surgery and Medicine, and Japan Association of Microscopic Dentistry. He was awarded the Leon Goldman Award for Clinical Excellence in Laser Dentistry from the Academy of Laser Dentistry in 2010, the Excellent Presentation Prize of the Japanese Academy of Color for Dentistry in 2008 and Dr. Glenda Payas Outstanding Educator Award from the Academy of Laser Dentistry in 2022. Dr. Nagai maintains a full-time private dental practice in Tokyo, Japan. Dr. Nagai is visiting lecturer at Tokyo Medical and Dental University Photoperiodontics, Department of Periodontology.
